Dear Student,

You will be taking your AP Exam(s) very shortly. If you have not attended a pre-administration session with your AP Coordinator, Mrs. Conway, you need to arrange for an appointment immediately. This is mandatory in order to take an exam.

See the attached schedule and review it carefully for accuracy. If you see any discrepancies, please contact Mrs. Conway in room 203 immediately. Lunch times have been added into the schedule and students taking more than one exam on a given day have been considered and will not miss any part of any exam. Your AP Teacher also has posted a schedule in his/her room.

You should bring the following items to the exam:

- Several sharpened No. 2 pencils (with erasers) for all multiple-choice answer sheets. **NO MECHANICAL PENCILS.**
- Pens with black or dark blue ink for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.
- A watch (in case your exam room does not have a clock that you can see easily).
- A calculator with the necessary capabilities if you're taking an AP Calculus, Chemistry, Physics, or Statistics exam. Visit [www.collegeboard.com/ap/calculators](http://www.collegeboard.com/ap/calculators) to learn more about the calculator policy for each of these exams, and for a list of authorized calculators. **ALSO SEE ATTACHED SHEET.**
- A ruler or straightedge if you're taking an AP Physics Exam.
- Your social security number for identification purposes (optional). If you provide it, the number will appear on your AP Grade Reports.

You SHOULD NOT BRING the following to the exam:

- CELL PHONES, BEEPERS, PAGERS, MP3 PLAYERS, OR PERSONAL DIGITAL ASSISTANTS (PDA'S)
- Books, compasses, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes.
- Rulers and straightedges (except as noted above).
- Scratch paper (notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets).
- Computers (except as noted for students with disabilities), or calculators (except as noted on the attached sheet).
- Watches that beep or have an alarm
- Portable listening or recording devices (even with headphones) or photographic equipment
- Clothing with subject-related information
- **DO NOT DRAW OR WRITE INAPPROPRIATELY ON YOUR GREEN INSERTS OR IN THE FREE RESPONSE SECTIONS OF YOUR TESTS.**

You are required to check in from 7:30-7:44 for the morning administration, and follow the schedule check in times for the afternoon. **DO NOT BE LATE.**

Some exams will be administered at The Pilcher Park Conservatory and at Central Campus. You are not allowed to drive to the alternate sites. You must be transported by bus to and from the site.

**BOARD BUSES AT THE CWC ENTRANCE BY THE DESIGNATED TIME. DO NOT BE LATE. BUSES WILL NOT WAIT. IF YOU MISS THE BUS, YOU FORFEIT YOUR EXAM OPPORTUNITIES.**

Students may not be dismissed until an exam has officially ended. Do not ask to leave early if you finish before the end of the test, as your request will be denied. Some exams will go over the regular scheduled school day times. If you play a sport or have a job, it will be your responsibility to inform your coach or employer of your AP obligation and arrangements should be made accordingly.

You are allowed to bring a snack for the scheduled breaks.

You are required to abide by the policies of both the College Board and Lockport Township High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam grade. If you decide not to take an exam and have already paid for it, **NO REFUNDS WILL BE GIVEN FOR MISSED EXAMS.**

**Calculus AB & BC:** Both the multiple-choice and free response sections of the AP Calculus AB & BC exam contain questions that require a graphing calculator and questions that do not allow the use of a graphing calculator. See above list.

**Chemistry and Physics:** Calculators are permitted for Part A of the free response section for the AP Chemistry Exam and the entire free response section of AP Physics. Most types of scientific and graphing calculators can be used. See above list.

**Statistics:** Each student is expected to bring a graphing calculator with statistical capabilities to the AP Statistics Exam.
