

Lockport Township High School Foundation

Minigrant Criteria

Revised July 2010

The LTHS Foundation will award minigrants to faculty members as funds are available. The typical amount per minigrant is \$250.00 (although exceptions may be made based on the merit of individual requests). For full consideration, grants **must** meet the following criteria:

- 1) Projects must directly affect the academic progress of our students or be aimed at students' health and well-being.
- 2) Funding for projects cannot replace budgeted funds.
- 3) Requests for food will be denied.
- 4) Proposals must (a) be submitted in writing at least thirty (30) days prior to event attendance or purchase of requested funds, (b) specify the total dollar amount requested, and (c) include a brief rationale for the project.
- 5) Projects must have the written approval of the building principal and department chair of the person making the request.
- 6) If chosen to receive a minigrant, the recipient(s) is/(are) required to submit (a) paperwork for processing or reimbursement of funds within thirty (30) days from the date of notification of approval, and (b) a brief written report after completion of each project (i.e., describe results/merits of student performance as a result of minigrant funding, indicate if additional funding was provided by other entities, include comments by student beneficiaries, etc.).
- 7) Each department must follow the proper procedures in reporting to the Foundation the outcome of a previously awarded minigrant before consideration will be given to additional requests from that department.

The Foundation will examine each proposal based on its merit. Generally, funds are not intended to purchase equipment and supplies that typically are provided by the school budget.

Special consideration will be given to projects that go across the curriculum or benefit a large number of students.

Examples of fundable projects:

- guest speakers
- classroom software
- projects that facilitate adding innovative teaching techniques
- units that fall outside the general curriculum
