This will enable an opportunity for all parents, and/or guardians to be able to communicate with the school that was similar to PARENTCONNECT last school year.

It is **Important** and **mandatory** that all sophomore, junior, and senior students register in person with a parent or legal guardian at East Campus before the start of the 2010 – 2011 school year. Student schedules will be administered once you have fulfilled the orientation process accordingly.

Please bring the following so that the orientation process will go smoothly:

RESIDENCY CHECK: Two proofs of residency examples include: a current utility bill, real estate contract, (closing document), tax bill, telephone bill, or driver’s license with proof of insurance.

EPAS: Dr. Bruce Lane will conduct presentations in the East Auditorium regarding the EPAS System (Explore, Plan, ACT Testing). He will provide an understanding of the scoring.

NEW Parent Portal: The technology staff will be available to demonstrate the new parent portal. Your old usernames and passwords will not work in the new system. You will be provided with information for the new log in process.
