

LTHS Haiti Relief Fund

The major efforts of LTHS activities, sports and clubs to raise funds for Haiti relief will begin **Monday, January 25 and go through February 20**, although donations will continue to be accepted until the end of the 2009-2010 school year. Our biggest push for funds will be made during **LTHS Haiti Relief Week, February 12-February 20**. Four non-profit charities were chosen at the meeting based on faculty and student interest, reliability or relationship with the organizations and a balance of short and long term aide these organizations could provide.

These organizations are Doctors without Borders, ShelterBox (in conjunction with Lockport Rotary), Schools Count Corp, and Share your Soles. National Honor Society has generously volunteered to match funds up to \$2500. Apart from collecting change in class competitions in the cafeteria and all LTHS activities, sports and events, our campaign consists of two major events, the Feb. 12 basketball game where Coach John Meyer will coach barefoot along with other volunteers to help collect shoes and funds, and a Hunger Banquet organized by Beth Czako, ROTC, Spanish Honor Society and International Club (time and place TBA).
