Dear Parents/Guardians:

The Lockport faculty members are offering a review course for this spring's PSAT/ACT. This nationally recognized test is used by colleges and universities as selection criteria for admittance.

Review courses frequently help students improve scores by diminishing anxiety and teaching them the format of the test. While enrolling in such a course does not ensure higher test scores, students often benefit from the attention given to the reading at a college level, the review of writing skills, the process of comprehending science passages, and the math survey of important concepts learned in high school. Afternoon and evening sessions are available for students taking the ACT test.

The five-week *afternoon* review course will begin on **March 16**, and sessions will run from 4:15 p.m. to 5:30 p.m. at the East Campus Maroon Room, and the activity bus will be available. The afternoon workshop dates are as follows:

The five-week *early evening* review course will begin on **March 16**, and sessions will run from 6:15 pm to 7:30 pm. at the East Campus Maroon Room. Students must provide their own transportation. It is very *important* to note that each student is *expected* to complete the Practice Test 1 from the study guide at home prior to the first review session in each subject. Each part of the Practice Test 1 take from 30 to 60 minutes and serve as a starting point for the review.

Again, this clinic is provided for students taking the PSAE/ACT on April 28th. Enrollment is guaranteed for the **first 144 paid** registrants (**72** for the afternoon session and **72** for the early evening session). The fee is \$75 to be made payable to L.T.H.S. (**no cash is accepted**) and is to be included with the attached registration form. The course will include the textbook *Cambridge TestPrep Plus* and two practice ACT examinations. Please return both the payment *and the* registration form to the East Guidance Services office. Registration will close Wednesday, February 24th, 2010 at 3:00 pm.
