1. Before each presentation (English, Math, Science Reasoning, Reading), complete the first ACT practice test, review all answers, and be prepared to question your mistakes.
2. Expect to take the ACT Assessment on your own. Again, answer and explanations are provided for your reference.
3. Note that one third of this clinic's preparation is independent. Therefore, the importance of homework cannot be emphasized enough. Simply attending the eight classes will not prepare you for the exam. Practicing concepts, strategies, and timing will be necessary for both speed and accuracy.
4. Be punctual; all sessions begin *promptly* at either 4:15 p.m. for the afternoon course or 6:15 p.m. for the evening course in the Maroon Room at the East Campus.
5. Obtain any handouts and complete the next assignment if you miss a session.
6. Remember that 60% of the test is based on reading. Make a special effort during the next months to read with varied paces and different types of printed material. Also, be aware of punctuation.
7. Be confident! Having understood the format, timings, and approaches to each subject area, you should be prepared for this major test.
