

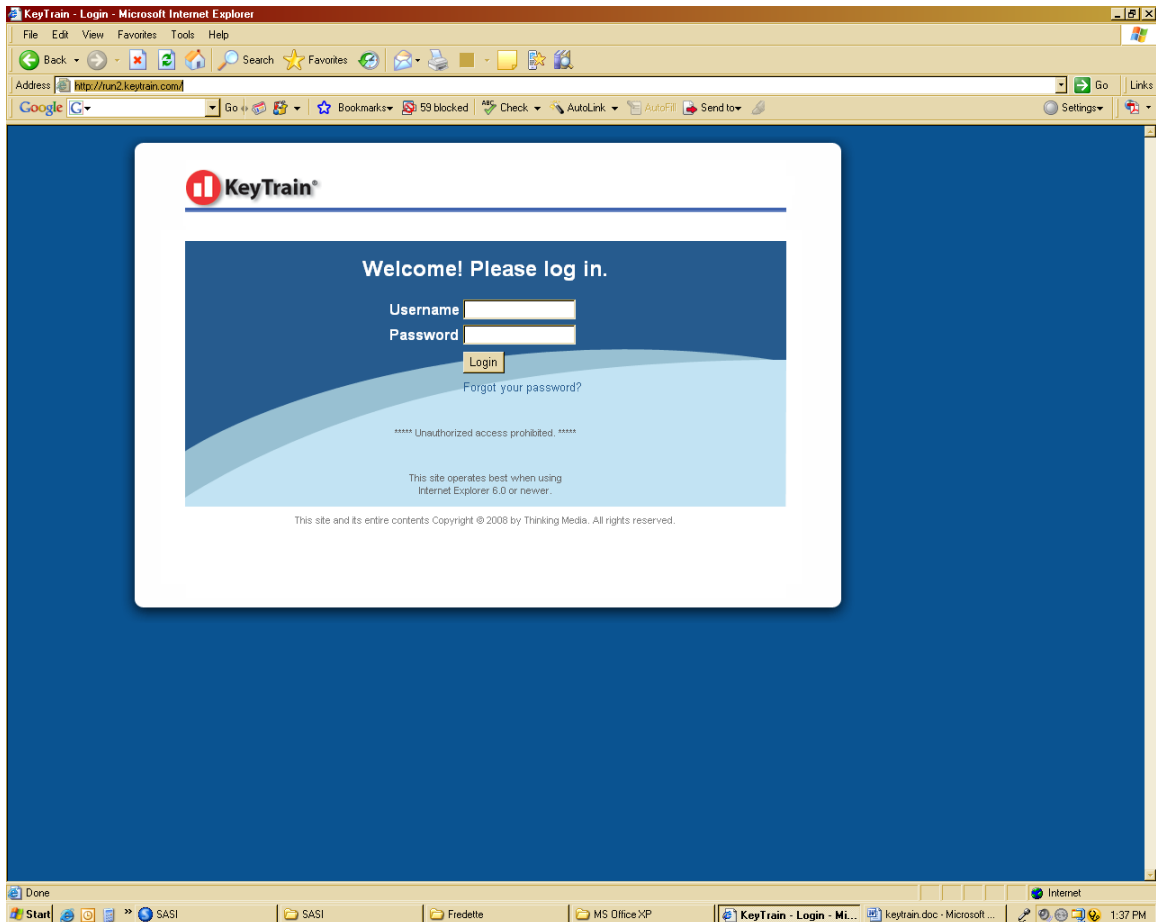
## Logging On to KeyTrain

2. The following screen will appear. Enter your username and password as follows. See the example below on how to enter your username and password.

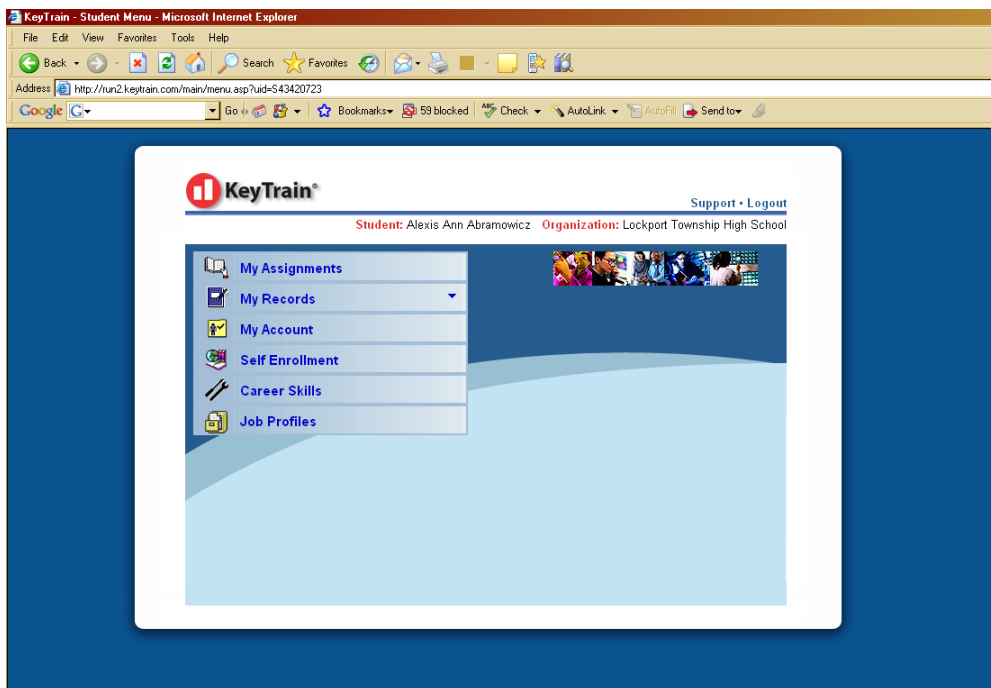
Example: Student ID: 205017654

Username: LTHS017654

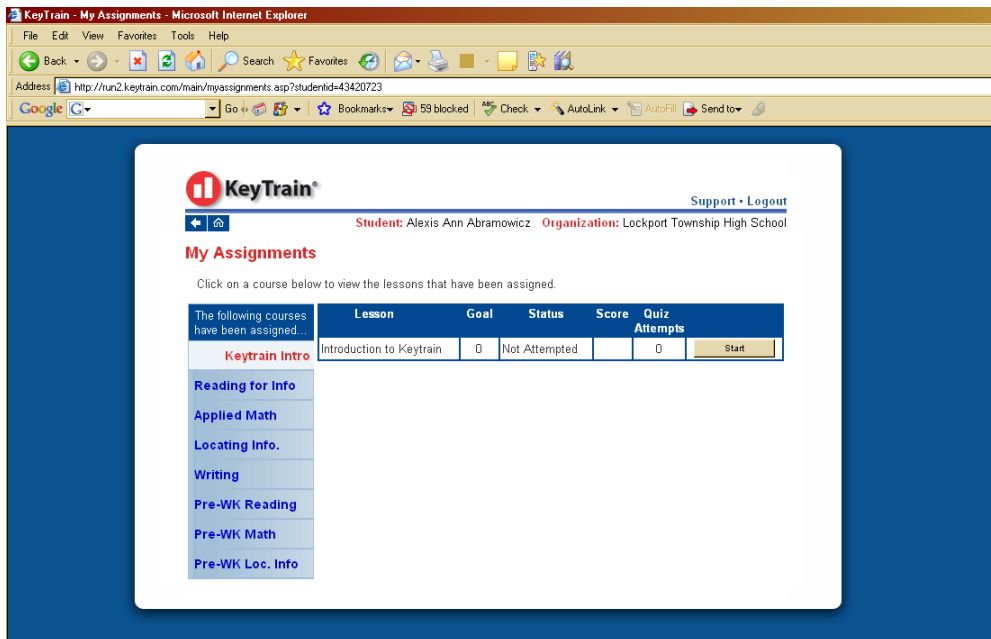
Password: LTHS2010

# KeyTrain Technical Specifications

## KeyTrain Program Requirements - Internet Version

The KeyTrain Internet version can be used on computers running the Microsoft Windows® operating system.

Requirements for using the KeyTrain Internet version fall into these categories:

- **Computer hardware**
- **Internet Browser**
- **Web Software**
- **Internet Connection**

### Computer Hardware

- Microsoft Windows
- Screen resolution of 800x600 or higher.
- Pentium or better processor (Pentium 200 MHz or more recommended)
- 128MB or more RAM (256 MB or more recommended)
- Windows 98, ME, XP, NT 4.0, 2000 or better
- Windows-compatible sound card required for Writing, Listening, Business Writing, Observation and Teamwork; recommended for Applied Mathematics, Reading for Information, Locating Information and Applied Technology. Headphones recommended instead of speakers in a lab environment.

### Internet Browser

KeyTrain Internet requires Internet Explorer Version 5 or higher.

### Web Player Software

KeyTrain Internet requires the Macromedia Authorware Web Player Version 2004. This will be installed for you the first time you run a lesson on a given computer.

The installation may take up to 30 minutes on a 56k dialup modem (less if you have a better connection). You must have administrator access to Windows to install the player, and grant trusting security to the KeyTrain lessons when asked.
