

Lockport Township High School Foundation Scholarship

Two-year or Four-year College, University, or Trade/Technical School

Eligibility Requirements

1. Rank in the upper 25 percent of Lockport Township High School's Class of 2010
2. Attendance at a two-year or four-year college/university or a trade or technical school
3. Two letters of recommendation, one from a faculty member and one from a community leader
4. A short essay (250 words) describing yourself, your goals for the future, and how you arrived at this point in your life
5. A current copy of your family's complete federal income tax return (i.e., Form 1040, Form 1040A, or Form 1040 EZ) *Failure to submit all income tax returns from both parents/guardians is cause for disqualification unless disclosed by applicant with an appropriate explanation.*

Scholarship Facts

The recipient of the LTHS Foundation Scholarship will receive a **\$2,500.00** award. Emphasis will be placed on selecting a student who is able to demonstrate financial need.

As part of the Lockport Township High School Foundation Scholarship Program, the LTHS Foundation is proud to honor individuals who have contributed significantly to our organization by naming scholarships in their honor.

The **Richard C. Stringham Scholarship** honors the ongoing support and contributions of a true friend of Lockport Township High School, Dick Stringham, who served on the LTHS Board of Education from 1997 through 2005. As a Board of Education member, he was instrumental in establishing the LTHS Foundation, whose main functions are to acquire materials, services, and funding for students and staff beyond those allotted by the school budget and to promote and support a positive relationship between LTHS and its communities. Mr. Stringham served as the Board of Education's liaison to the LTHS Foundation from January 2000 through March 2003.

The **Patricia (Pat) Zanier Brown Scholarship** acknowledges a valued LTHS Class of 1966 alumna who holds her alma mater and its students close to her heart. She served as a member of the LTHS Foundation from September 2002 through January 2004. Since 2002, Pat has volunteered to assist in the LTHS Foundation's Annual Golf Outing, an event held every June that raises funds for the following academic year's scholarships awarded to graduating seniors. In the weeks preceding this event, Mrs. Brown works tirelessly to obtain prizes from local vendors for the raffle held in conjunction with the golf outing. Pat also is recognized for coordinating the sale of raffle tickets in the weeks preceding and through the day of the event.
