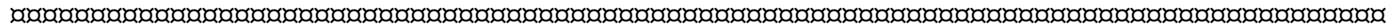

LTHS Welcomes New Central Principal And Familiar Faces In New Roles

Lockport Township High School District is proud to announce its new principal of Central campus, Dr. Paige Dague.

Dague, formerly assistant superintendent at Thornton Township High School in South Holland, began her new role at the freshmen campus on July 1. She replaces former Central campus principal Dennis Hicks, who recently was promoted to principal at East campus, which serves sophomores, juniors and seniors.

Former East campus Principal Dr. Brett Gould has been named assistant superintendent of curriculum.

Dague earned a doctorate majoring in curriculum and instruction from Loyola University in 2007 and two master degrees from Governors State University in 2004 and 2000, one in school counseling and one in administration, respectively.

She began her career in education as a social studies teacher at a private school and later served as a school counselor at Lincoln-Way and Homewood-Flossmoor high schools. After being promoted to guidance counselor chair at H-F, she later was named assistant principal before moving on to Thornton High School as assistant superintendent of accountability and transition.

Hicks, who has served as the Central principal for the past four years, also began his new role as East campus principal on July 1.

Hicks earned his master degree in educational administration in 1996 from Governor's State University and later served as assistant principal at Valley View High School from 2002 to 2006

before coming to Central campus. Prior to his role at Valley View, Hicks served as dean of students and a math teacher at LTHS.

Gould, who has served as principal at East campus for the past five years, recently earned a doctorate majoring in educational administration from Illinois State University. He also has a master degree in educational administration from Governor's State University, which was awarded in 1988.

Gould began his career in education as a social studies teacher at Union School and Romeoville High School before becoming the humanities division chairperson at Bolingbrook High School in 1992. He became dean of students at LTHS in 1994 and later served as assistant principal before becoming principal at East campus.
