

CWC Pool Rental Guidelines



Listed below are rules and regulations that your group will need to follow when using the swimming pool at the **Lockport Township High School Community Wellness Center**. These rules and safety standards are used so everyone in your party will come away with a safe and positive experience.

- The lifeguards will meet with your group for 5 minutes at the beginning of your party to discuss the importance of safety and following the rules.
- All swimmers must be in a swim suit. No street clothes are allowed on deck or in the swimming pool.
- No one is to be on the pool deck at any time with street shoes.
- All parents need to be in a swim suit if they choose to swim or supervise their swimmers on deck. If you decide not to wear a bathing suit, we ask that you watch the party from the balcony area. This is for your safety as well as the lifeguards.
- Flotation devices are welcome on the shallow half of the pool.
- This would include noodles, rafts, beach balls, water wings and life jackets.
- Lifejackets with a snap between the legs are the only flotation device permitted in the deep end. These need to be coast guard approved. You can find the seal of approval on the inside of your life jacket.
- All swimmers must take a shower prior to entering the pool.
- One swimmer at a time on the diving boards, no double bouncing.
- There is no food or drink allowed on the pool deck. These are rules we are forced to follow do to health codes with the state.
- The lifeguards are here for you. If you have any questions or concerns during your party, please address them to the lifeguard on duty.
