FIELD HOUSE POLICIES

The following policies have been established to ensure the safety and enjoyment of all participants. The Community Wellness Center Customer Service Representatives have the authority and responsibility to enforce these policies. Noncompliance can result in potential suspension or termination of facility privileges.

ALCOHOL AND DRUGS: No one will be permitted to use equipment or the Field House under the influence of alcohol or other drugs. You will be asked to leave the facility immediately.

BASKETBALL: Participants playing basketball may not dunk or hang on any part of the basket assembly. Participants engaging in this type of activity will be removed from the Field House without a refund for a period of time to be determined by the Community Wellness Center Director.

CHILDREN: During open gym children under high school age must be accompanied by a parent at all times. You must be at least an incoming freshman to come to open gym or to participate in Intramurals, or have a CWC membership.

CLOSING TIME: All activities in the Field House will be stopped ten minutes before the listed closing time.

DRESS CODE:

- No headwear of any kind is allowed. This includes hats, hoods, cloth pullovers, or any other type of head wear, which the Field House staff sees as a safety hazard. (All headwear must be removed at the front door of the Community Wellness Center when checking in.
- Street clothes are not allowed in the Field House during athletic activities.

EQUIPMENT IN FIELD HOUSE: No climbing or horsing around on the equipment stored in Field House.

EXITS: The main entrance to the Community Wellness Center is the only acceptable entrance/exit to the facility. Participants entering the facility must check in with the Community Wellness Center receptionist with the valid ID. In case of emergency, the Community Wellness Center staff will authorize any other designated acceptable exits. Noncompliance with this policy will not be tolerated and will result in termination of facility privileges.

FOOD OR BEVERAGE: No food or beverage, other than water, is allowed on the main floor, fitness room, weight room or running track. It is allowed only in the vending area.

FOOTWEAR: Participants may wear only gym shoes. Shoes worn on the street will not be allowed. No spikes or high heeled shoes are allowed. Field House participants should carry in the shoes they will be wearing for play. Dark soled gym shoes (black, gray, red) damage the Field House floor. Consequently, we ask that you bring shoes that comply with this policy. As shoes are manufactured that could potentially damage the floor, we will alert participants. Lockport Township High School CWC reserves the right to refuse any participant whose shoes may damage the Field House floor.

GUM CHEWING: Is not allowed.

INDOOR PRACTICE RENTALS: Practice ball only for baseball and softball rentals.

LOITERING: Loitering is not allowed.

LOSS OF PERSONAL PROPERTY: The Field House is not responsible for the loss of participants clothing, equipment or valuables.

NETTING: Nets can be lowered to divide the courts from the track. The Community Wellness Center staff has a key to lower the nets and is the only person authorized to do so. During open recreation, the nets will be lowered to protect the participants on the track. The nets are to be used as a backdrop. No activity is permitted to throw directly into the net. No one is allowed to lift a net to go underneath. This activity throws the cables off their track. Entrance can be gained from the corners of the courts.

POLICIES AND PROCEDURES: The policies found in the Student Handbook are expected to be adhered to. Any non-compliance will be subject to potential suspension or termination of facility privileges.

SPITTING ON THE FLOOR: Spitting is not allowed.

SPORTSMANSHIP: Any participants engaging in a fight or other act of poor sportsmanship (unsportsmanship acts, unaccepted language, etc.) will, without refund, be removed from the Field House for a period of time set by the Community Wellness Director.

STROLLERS: There are no strollers allowed in the Field House.

TOBACCO-FREE FACILITY: In accordance with the Drug Free Schools and Campuses Act of 1989, all Student Recreation and Fitness Center venues are tobacco-free. No chewing or smoking is allowed.
