

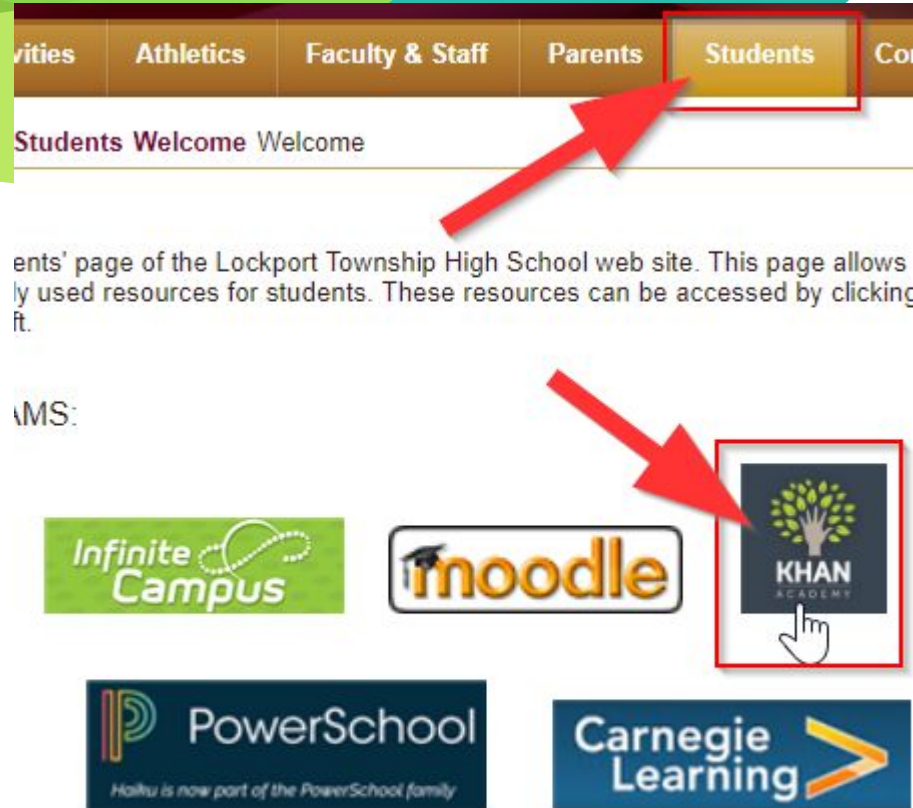
Getting Started with Khan Academy and SAT Prep.

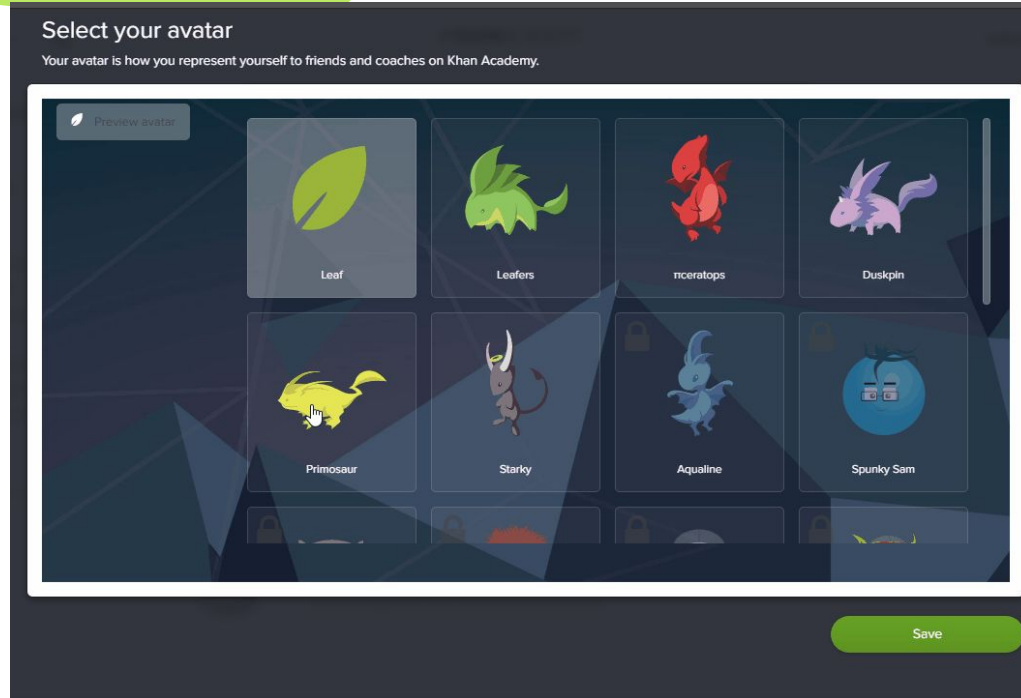
- ◆ Once you're on the LTHS Homepage, click on students. Once on the student page, click on the Khan Academy Logo.



Getting Started - First Time

- ◆ If you **HAVE used** Khan Academy with an LTHS account go to the next slide.

- ◆ If you have **NEVER** used Khan academy before with your LTHS account you'll have to go through the setup pages like picking an Avatar, and verifying your age. Once you're through this you'll be on the subjects page.
- ◆ Click on **SAT** under Test Prep.



Getting Started - Return User

- ◆ If you've used Khan Academy before then you'll be on your Dashboard when you log in. Locate **Subjects** in the upper right hand corner, hover on it, and then click **SAT** under **Test Prep**.

LINKING SAT SCORES

- ◆ Once you're on the SAT page it will give you 2 options to get started
- ◆ A: To sign in with your CollegeBoard.org account and link your PSAT results
- ◆ B: Take a diagnostic quiz
NOTE: You should have SAT results available if you have taken the exam at least once but if not go ahead and take a diagnostic quiz.
- ◆ Once you've made your selection click **Onward** in the bottom right.

Have you taken the PSAT or SAT already? If so, we'd love to start by practicing what you missed on the test.

To make this happen, we'll have you sign in to CollegeBoard.org and send your test results to Khan Academy. This will enable you to skip our diagnostic quizzes.

◆ The page will redirect you to the College Board login for the SAT/PSAT. If you already have an account, go ahead and login. If not, click **SIGN UP** and follow the sign up prompts.
