



East Campus Principal Selected

The Lockport Township High School District 205 Board of Education has named Dr. John Greenan as the Principal of East Campus to succeed Dennis Hicks, who is retiring at the end of the school year.

Dr. Greenan has served District 205 for the past 17 years in a number of significant roles, as teacher, coach, dean and most recently Assistant Principal at East Campus. During his tenure, he has demonstrated his commitment to serve and inspire the district's students. Dr. Greenan's leadership skills and personal qualities distinguished him among the 40 applicants.

Dr. Greenan earned his bachelor's, master's and doctoral degree from the University of St. Francis.
