Who:

- **Vaccine:** Any Lockport Township High School Student and their family members may register for the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna Vaccination Doses. (Johnson and Johnson is not available at this time).
 - If you are interested in getting a first or second dose vaccine just register yourself/your student as needing a Booster; then notify the OSCO staff on that day that it will be a first/second dose and not a Booster.
- **Booster:** Anyone who has completed the primary vaccination series (2x doses of Pfizer/Moderna or 1x dose of Johnson and Johnson) and are at least five months past their second dose or two months past their single vaccination Johnson and Johnson may receive the COVID-19 booster shot.

The registration link will allow individuals to choose a Pfizer or Moderna vaccination.

Note: The second dose may be arranged through contacting the OSCO pharmacy in Lockport.

If you or your student have tested Positive for COVID-19, in the last 90 days, please consult your physician as to your eligibility to receive the primary series or the Booster.

Registration:

Students and family members should park in the Farrell Road Parking Lot and enter/exit through Door #10 for entrance into registration. Wearing well-fitted masks and maintaining 6-ft distance will be enforced. **If you are experiencing any COVID-19 symptoms, please do not attend this clinic.**

At the registration table, you will be asked if you want :

- A. The first/second dose of the primary series of Pfizer or Moderna
- B. The COVID-19 booster shoot

You must bring:

1. A paper copy of the completed/signed consent form (Please use the Internet Link or QR Code below) - each person receiving the doses must have their own permission/registration form.
2. Your License or State of IL ID
3. Your Vaccination Card for an Updated sticker

NOTE:

Any student under the age of 18 must have parent/guardian consent to receive the vaccination.

The entire process (registration, vaccines, wait time) should not take more than 20-25 minutes.
